Construction update for July 13-17

Water service switchovers to the new system will be completed this week for homes on the west side of Brandywine Avenue.

As connections are made, water to homes will be shut off for **up to 3 hours**. Residents will be notified at least 48 hours in advance with a door hanger.

The 34 addresses listed below will be converted on Monday, July 13:

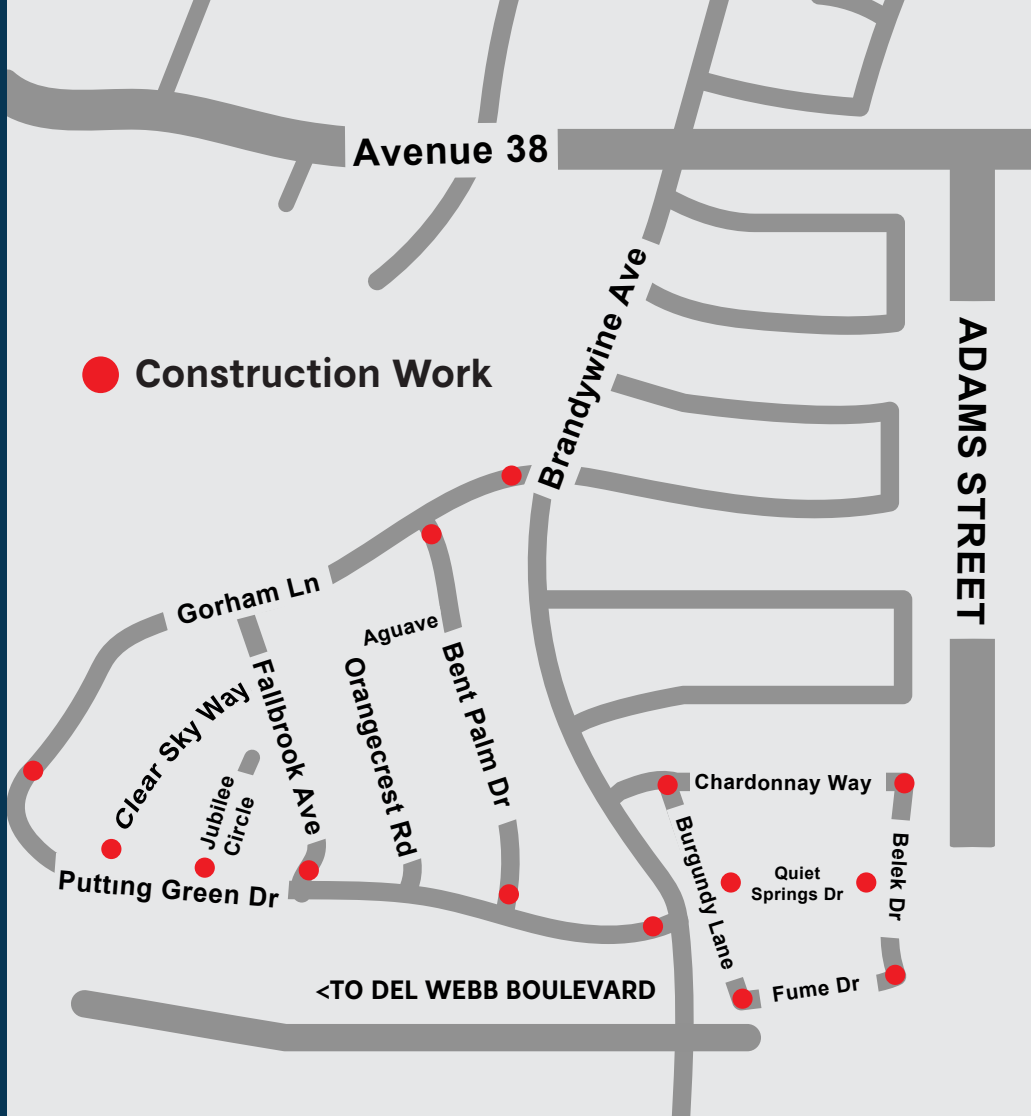
North side of Gorham Lane:

78556, 78566, 78576, 78586, 78596, 78606, 78616, 78626, 78636, 78646, 78656, 78666, 78676, 78686, 78696, 78706, 78716, 78726, 78736, 78746, 78756, 78766, 78776, 78786, 78796, and 78806.

South side of Gorham: 78671, 78681, 78691, 78701, 78711, 78721, 78731, and 78781.

Also on the **west side of Brandywine** this week, crews will be removing old fire hydrants and air valves, repairing and replacing concrete on sidewalks, removing utility paint markings and cleaning up around water meters and fire hydrants to prepare for paving.

On the **east side of Brandywine**, the installation of new water services will be completed, and the lines will be pressure tested, flushed, chlorinated and dechlorinated. Homes in this section are scheduled to connect to the new system in early August.



Mail Deliveries

Mail for homes in the construction area will be delivered the following day to the Sun City Postal Center, where it will be held for pick up.

The Postal Center is located in the Mountain View Clubhouse at Avenue 38 and Del Webb Boulevard and is open Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. For more information, please contact the Postal Center at **760-200-2236**.

About the SCPD Pipeline Replacement Project

Coachella Valley Water District is replacing ductile iron pipelines throughout the community that are failing because of soil corrosion.

The 10-year project includes new water mains, water service laterals, valves, fire hydrants and street paving.

The work will improve water reliability for the community by reducing main breaks and emergency repairs.
