Construction update for October 26-30

This week, crews will be working on abandoning the old mainline by filling it with slurry.

On Monday and Tuesday, **October 26-27**, work is scheduled along Brandywine Avenue, from 38th Street down to Brandywine Park, and the streets east of Brandywine Avenue between Champagne Lane and Mimosa Drive.

The remainder of the week will be spent removing old fire hydrants in the same area.

Traffic control will be in place, but the streets will remain open.

PHASE 2A: Installation of water services will continue on Nectarine Drive and fire hydrants will be put in place on Apricot Lane.

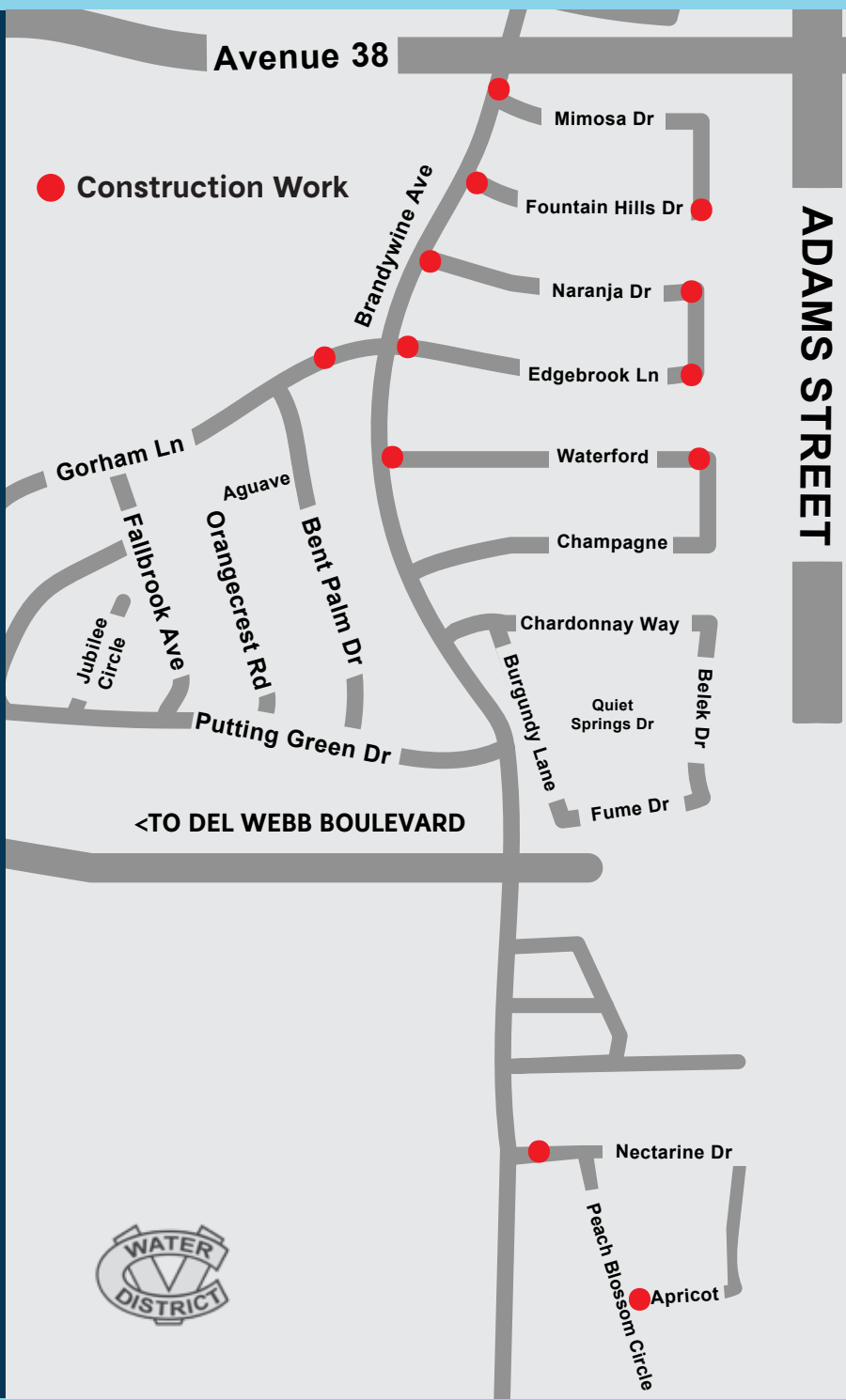
Property Damage Release Forms

About the SCPD Pipeline Replacement Project
