Construction Update for December 14-18

PHASE 1C – Crews will finish installing service laterals, hydrants and valves on Pineknoll Avenue from Avenue 38 to just north of Turnberry Isle Drive.

Access will not be limited but please watch for equipment, vehicles and materials in the street.

PHASES 1A and 1B – Cleanup is expected to be complete on both sides of Brandywine Avenue by Wednesday, December 16.

The work includes:

- Cleanup of utility markings on curbs, sidewalks, hardscapes, and private property
- Restoring grass, gravel, or hardscape disturbed by installation of water meters and fire hydrants
- Replacing sidewalk panels damaged as part of the waterline project
- Power sweeping sidewalks
- Removing debris resulting from construction work

Homeowners in these areas should have received a **PROPERTY DAMAGE RELEASE FORM** to certify that their property and landscaping have been returned to pre-construction condition.
