Planned street closures for March 16-20

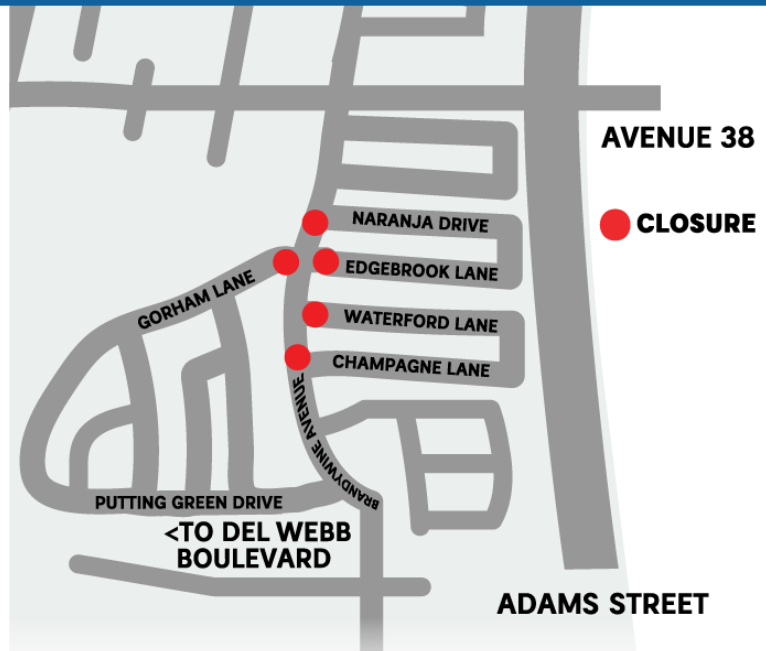
Work on the pipeline project is moving south on Brandywine Avenue, with closures planned for next week between Naranja Drive and Champagne Lane. (See map below.)

Please follow detour signs and avoid walking or driving around construction areas, where crews are trenching with heavy equipment.

We at Coachella Valley Water District appreciate your patience as we replace corroded pipelines. The entire project includes 44 miles of new pipe throughout Sun City Palm Desert, as well as new valves, fire hydrants and street paving.

The work will improve water reliability for the community by reducing main breaks and emergency repairs.

Mail and package delivery changes in construction area

If you live on streets where temporary construction closures prevent the U.S. Postal Service or other delivery services from accessing your residence, delivery may be delayed or mail and packages may be held for residents at the Sun City Palm Desert postal center, which is located in the main clubhouse at Avenue 38 and Del Webb Boulevard. Please work directly with private delivery services to arrange deliveries if construction is affecting access.
