Construction update for July 6-10

Water service switchovers to the new system will begin this week on the west side of Brandywine Avenue.

As connections are made, water to homes will be shut off for up to 3 hours. We will notify residents at least 48 hours in advance with a door hanger. You can also check the schedule below to see if and when your property may be impacted.

If crews cannot complete all changeovers scheduled in a day, the work will be finished the following day.

Tuesday, July 7

On Putting Green (south side) beginning at 38781 Brandywine Avenue and into Gorham Lane (west side) to 78566 Gorham.

Wednesday, July 8

On Putting Green (north side) beginning at 38741 Brandywine and into Gorham (north side, east side, south side, including Jubilee Circle) to 78661 Gorham; south side of Clear Sky Way 38504, 38574, 38524, 38504, and north side 38619 Clear Sky.

Thursday, July 9

(Pending, if all Tuesday/Wednesday switchovers are completed)

On Clear Sky (north side) beginning at 38559, 38579, 38559, 38539, 38519, 38499, and 38479; 78704 Putting Green, Fallbrook Avenue (both sides) from 38462 to 38622 Fallbrook, and north side of Gorham 78576, 78586, 78596, 78606, 78616, 78626, 78636, 78646, 78656, 78666, 78676, and 78686 Gorham.



We will continue to update you on this important neighborhood project. Thank you for your patience and understanding while we work to improve water reliability!



Looking ahead

All homes on streets west of Brandywine Avenue should be connected to the new system by the end of July; homes on the east side of Brandywine are scheduled for switchover in early August.



Mail Deliveries

Mail for homes in the construction area will be delivered the following day to the Sun City Postal Center, where it will be held for pick up.

About the SCPD Pipeline Replacement Project

Coachella Valley Water District is replacing ductile iron pipelines throughout the community that are failing because of soil corrosion. The 10-year project includes new water mains, water service laterals, valves, fire hydrants and street paving. The work will improve water reliability for the community by reducing main breaks and emergency repairs.
